

**Bounty Land Application for Benjamin Gilbert**

In response to your letter dated March 22, 1906 and received March 23, 1906, you are advised that the records of this Bureau show that Benjamin Gilbert was a private and Lieutenant of the New York Line on the Continental Establishment, and served until the close of the Revolutionary War.

His widow, March S. Gilbert was a resident of Otsego Co., New York, in 1855, at which time she was eighty-eight years of age, and his son, Benjamin Gilbert Jr. resided in Otsego Co. New York, in 1829.
