

### **Pension Application for Timothy Gilbert**

R.4014 (Widow: Hannah)

State of New York

County of Dutchess SS.

On this 19<sup>th</sup> day of June AD 1841 personally appeared before me Morgan Carpenter Esq, one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for said County the said Court being a Court of Record, Timothy Gilbert a resident of the town of North East in said County, aged eighty one years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the Act of Congress passed June 7, 1832.

That he enlisted into the service of the United States under the following named officers and served therein as herein stated, to wit; he served in a company commanded by Captain Elisha Barlor in Colonel Grahams Regiment for six months, which period of service was terminated on the last day of December AD 1776.

The said service was performed principally in the County of WestChester in the state of New York aforesaid. He enlisted into said company and was not drafted, into the service.

The deponent was regularly discharged by Colonel Graham at the close of the service and ordered all the wages due to him at the close of the said service.

This deponent was in the action at White Plains. The following year 1777, the deponent was in the service for a period of four months. He then went as a substitute for a man who had been drafted, whose name this deponent does not now remember and who paid this deponent fifty dollars, Continental money. The said service was performed at Peekskill, principally in boating. This deponent was born in New Haven, he is eighty one years of at or the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February last, but has no record of his age. The deponent lived when called into the service in Armenia Dutchess County, New York and he lived in said county ever since.

He has not applied for a pension before for the reason that he had enough to support him without it and further said that the sum which he would draw would be small, but on account as it was [?] credible sum he now makes this application for the same.

He hereby relinquishes every claim, whatever to a Pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the Pension Roll of the agency of any state. (Signed with his mark) Timothy Gilbert
