

Pension Application for Thomas Glover

S.44164 Sergeant, Van Cortland's Regiment.

State of New York

Otsego County SS.

On this 20th day of June 1820 personally appeared in open court, being the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Otsego & State of New York, and being a Court of Record & proceeding according to the principles of the Common Law with power of fine & imprisonment, Thomas Glover aged 79 years resident in said County of Otsego, who first being duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows: In Capt Wright's company in Col. Cortland's Regiment being the 2nd Regiment of the New York Line & he is a pensioner under the act of Congress passed 18th March 1818 & the number of his pension certificate is 7,113 and the date of his original application the 21st day of April 1818—

And I Thomas Glover do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March, 1818, and that I have not since that time by gift, sale, or in any manner, disposed of my property, or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of the Act of Congress entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land & naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War, passed on the 18th day of March 1818, and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me, any property or securities contracts of debts due to me, nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed & by me subscribed. (Signed with his mark) Thomas Glover
