Pension Application for Isaac Goff

On this 16 day of June 1820 personally appeared in open court, being a court of record for the said county of Montgomery called the court of Common Pleas, proceeding according to the principal of Common Law, having the power of fine and imprisonment, Isaac Goff aged sixty four years, resident in Johnstown in said State aforesaid, who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he served in the revolutionary war as follows, in Captain Cornelius VanDyke's Barent TenEyck, and Andrew Finck's Companies, Colonel Gooshum [Goose] VanSchaick's Regiment and New York line as is more particularly mentioned in my original declaration that my original declaration was made on the 11th day of May 1819 and the number of my pension certificate which I have received is 15,370—

And I solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift, sale or in any manner, disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bmyself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled and act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities, contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed. Real property I have none eather [either] in possession, reversion, remainder or expectancy. Personal Property 1 Iron Stove and pipe, 1 lot of Shoemaker's tooks, 1 chest, one iron pot.

I am a Shoemaker by occupation but being old cannot see very well and do not work much I have no family and have no other means of support except the pension I receive from the United States—William Castleman owes me \$15.00—Isaac Goff
