

Pension Application for Morris Green

R.4250 (Widow: Elizabeth)

Letter in folder dated June 27, 1914, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated the 24th instant, you are advised that in the papers in the claim R.F. #4,250 Rev. War, it is alleged that Moses [sic] Green was born May 26, 1751, entered the service in New York City, in the autumn of 1775, in Captain Lamb's Company N.Y. Artillery, and was in Arnold's Expedition to Quebec.

He married at Hempstead Queen's County, L.I. late in 1778, Elizabeth ____ who was born November 5, 1759. He died at Goshen, Orange County N.Y. April 21, 1801. She died February 15, 1852. Their children were: Mehetebel born March 24, 1780, Sarah born Aug. 15, 1782, James born May 5, 1784, Hannah born Sept. 2, 1787, Mathsemaria born October 10, 1790, Hiram born May 19, 1794.

On June 30, 1856, James the only surviving child, applied for pension on account of the services of his father, which was not allowed on the ground of children having no title to same.
