3 months—at the time of Arnold leaving the army—Cap Rose, Col. Hombarrack

5 months—entered about the time Gen. Washington moved south—Cap Jacob Conklin, General Hathorn.

Aged 84 years. Ohio—lived in Ulster County, New York during the war.
