

Pension Application for William Hallet or Hallett

I, William Hallet of the Town of Newburgh in the County of Orange and State of N. York do Solemnly swear – that he enlisted in the Spring of 1776 – with and under Capt Gillespie, and served under him four months.

Then I enlisted at NewBurgh aforesaid in the Month of November or December 1776 under Lt. Daniel Birdsall in Captain Philips Beivers Company in the fifth New York Regiment Commanded by Colonel Lewis DuBois—in General James Clinton’s Brigade for the term of three years on the Continental Establishment and I was discharged at or near MorrisTown in New Jersey; after that I served in Colonel Paulding’s Regiment.

I have never received any pension – and my discharge is lost and gone—and from my reduced circumstances I need the assistance of my Country for Support.
