

### **Pension Application for Staats Hammond**

No Papers.

There is no deposition or papers pertaining to the service of this soldier, however there is a letter dated April 12, 1916, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> instant, you are advised that in the report from the Secretary of War in relation to the Pension Establishment of the United States which was printed in 1835 on the list of Invalid Pensioners of Westchester County, New York, appears the name of Staats Hammond, a Sergeant in Hammond's New York Regiment, who was placed on the rolls June 8, 1786, at \$48 per annum from June 17, 1779, under Act June 7, 1785 and who died July 26, 1820.

There is no further information concerning him on file owing to the destruction of papers when the War Office was burned in 1800 and 1814.
