

Pension Application for John F. Hamtramck

B.L.Wt.983-300 Capt. Issued August 4, 1791. No Papers

Letter in folder dated October 1, 1926, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you that the Revolutionary War records of this bureau show that three hundred acres of bounty land were allowed on account of the services of John G. Hamtramck as Captain in the New York Troops, on Warrant 983 which was issued August 4, 1791.

There are no further data on file relative to John; F. Hamtramck and no data relative to his family, owing to the destruction of papers in bounty land claims when the War Office was burned in 1800.

The above noted is the only soldier by the name of Hamtramck that is found on the Revolutionary War records of this bureau and there is no record of a soldier named Hamtramick.
