

**Bounty Land Papers for Francis Hanmer**

B.L.Wt.989-200 Lt.

Issued Sept 28, 1790

Letter in folder dated August 15, 1928, written in response to an inquiry.

I advise you that from the Revolutionary War records of this Bureau it appears that Warrant Number 989, for two hundred acres of bounty land, was issued September 28, 1790, on account of the services of Francis Hanmer, Lieutenant of the New York Line, War of the Revolution.

There are no further data as to his services, and none whatever as to his family, owing to the destruction of papers in such claims, when the War Office was burned in November, 1800.

The above noted is the only soldier by that name found on the Revolutionary War records of this Bureau.
