

Pension Application for Israel Harriott

WestChester County SS:

On the 23rd day of May 1825 personally appeared in open court the same being a Court of Record for the County of WestChester Israel Harriott aged seventy seven years resident in White Plains in s^d County who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath Declare that he served in the revolutionary war as follows that the said Israel Harriott enlisted in the year 1777 for and during the war at Greenwich in the State of Connecticut in the Company commanded by Capt'n Samuel Lockwood In Col. Lamb's Regiment in New York line in the Continental Establishment that he continued in s^d service until peace took place when he was discahrg'd at West Point in the State of New York that he was at the taking of CornWallace in York Town in Virginia.

That sometime in the year 1818 he presented his original Declaration and [?] his certificate from the Secretary of War by Virtue of which s^d Certificate he Rec'd from the agent for paying pensions in the Citty [City] of New York one years Pensin that thro loss of memory or Nylect [neglect?] of friends the original certificate is lost.

That he cannot by any circumstance whatever bring to this recollection what had become of it.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift, sale or in any manner dispos'd of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval services of the United States in the Revolutionary War pass'd on the 18th of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities, Contracts or debts [due?] nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereunto annexed and by me subscribed. (Signed) Israel Harriott.
