

**Pension Application for John Hayes or Hays**

W.23179 (Widow: Olive)

State of New York

Chenango County SS.

On this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 1818 before me the Subscriber Charles Joplyn one of the Judges of Chenango Common Pleas in the State aforesaid personally appears John Hayes aged 52 years resident in the town of Cairo in the County of Greene in the state aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law doth make the following declaration, in order to obtain the provisions of the late act of Congress entitled an Act of provide for certain persons engaged in the land & naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war.

That he the said John Hayes inlisted in the year 1782 in the company commanded by Capt. Johnson in the New York Line and continued to serve in the said corps nine months the term of his inlistment, and was discharged at New Winsor [Windsor] in the State of New York.

That he was never in any regular battles but in some skirmishes that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support and that he has no other evidence of his said services now in his power-- (signed)
