

Pension Application for Robert Hill

W.15775 (Widow: Jane) Robert died 1814, Jane in 1842.

On this twenty fifth day of January in the year of our Lo9rd, one thousand eight hundred and forty two, personally appeared before me, Albert L. Baker a Judge of the County Courts of said County of the [???] in the Supreme Court of said County of Washington, Jane Hill, a resident of the town of Fortann in said County, aged eighty eight years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on her oath, make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 4, 1836.

That she is the widow of Robert Hill, deceased, who was a Corporal in Capt Smith's Company in col. Bigelow's Regiment of Massachusetts, on the 2d day of January, 1777, and continued in said service, in the Company and Regiment aforesaid, from that time, until the 31st day of December 1779.—which service will appear from the proofs hereunto annexed.

She further declares that she was married to said Robert Hill, in the town of Lunenburgh aforesaid, on the first day of October, in the year seventeen hundred and seventy eight; that her husband, the aforesaid Robert Hill died on the seventh day of June, 1814; and that she has remained a widow ever since that period, as will more fully appear by reference to the proof hereunto annexed.
