On this 5 day of Sept. 1837, before me the subscriber a Justice of Peace for the said County of Crawford personally appeared Joseph Hills who on his oath declares that he is the same person who formerly belonged to the company commanded by Capt. Patten in the Regiment commanded by Colonel Crane in the service of the United States that his name was placed on the pension roll of the State of New York from whence he has lately removed that he now resides in the State of Pennsylvania and County aforesaid where he intends to remain and resides his pension to be there payable in futer [future] and that his reason for removing to the State of Pennsylvania are because he has a son living here.
