His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 93.

Rank: Private

Regt: 1st New York

Disability: Disease contracted in the service.

Residence: Herkimer County

Remarks: Enlisted March 29, 1777

Evidence transmitted by the District Court incomplete, viz: Disability from known wounds not proved. No evidence of physicians. His continued disability not sufficiently authenticated.
