

Pension Application for Samuel Holly or Holley

W.8942 (Widow: Deborah) Married about 1784. Samuel died July 16, 1831.

For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of an act for the relief of An act for the relief of certain surviving officers and soldier of the Army of the revolution approved on the 15th day of May 1828, I Samuel Holley of [blank] in the county of Shelby in the state of Kentucky do hereby resolve that I entered in the continental line of the Army of the revolution for and during the [tear] period I was a private in Captain Hamtramicks company under Col. Phillips Vancortland. I also declare that I enlisted in the year 1779 but being very young and inexperienced I do not recollect of ever receiving a certificate under the resolve of Congress 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the fifteenth day of March 1828 on the pension list of the United States. (Signed) Samuel Holly
