

Bounty Land Application for Jeronius Hoogland or Hogeland

Know all men by these presents, that we Patty Lind widow of George Lind of the City of New York, Mary Armstrong wife of James Armstrong, Julia Guion, Lewis Guion, Jeromus Guion, and Charles Guion June, Catharine Hogeland and Elizabeth Hopkins all of EastChester in the County of WestChester and State of New York being all the heirs at law of Jeremus Hogeland deceased, late a captain in the County in New York line in the Army of the United States of America in the late war with Great Britain and who served during the whole of the said war, have authorized and empowered: and by these presents do authorize and empower James Sackett of Beaford in the County of WestChester and State of New York aforesaid to ask for and to receive from the Secretary of the War office of the United States at the City of Washington the Land Warrant or Warrants which we as the heirs of him the said Captain Jeromus Hogeland are entitled unto for his services as Captain as aforesaid during the whole of the said War – and for us and in our places and stead to do all and every act and thing which may be necessary in and about procuring the said Land Warrant or Warrants and one or more attornies under him for the purpose aforesaid to make and again at his pleasure to revoke—Hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever our said Attorney shall do or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these presents.—In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this twenty seventh day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and nine.
