

Pension Application for Timothy How

R.5247 (Former Widow: Zipporah Hoskins)

Be it known that on this 27th day of [blank] 1847 before the subscriber a Judge of Allegany County personally came Amanda M. Smith & made oath that she is one of the surviving children of Zipporah How who was [the] widow of Timothy How who was a soldier & officer in the American Revolutionary Army & resided at the date of his services at a place called the Nine Partners in the County of Dutchess & State of New York.

That the said Timothy How served under Col. Frazier & Col. Weisenfelt. That she is unable to state all the particulars in regard to his services. That the said Timothy How was married to Zipporah Cash at the said Nine Partners according to her best recollection in the year 1778. That he died in Cayuga County New York in the month of December 1820.

That the said Zipporah How died at Castile in the County of Wyoming on the 9th day of April in the year 1838.

This declaration is made in order to obtain the benefits of the provisions of the Act of July 4th 1836. Signed) Amanda M. Smith.
