

Pension Application for John Hudson

On this fifteenth day of May A.D. 1818, before me Gideon Friskbee the subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the county aforesaid in the state aforesaid personally appears John Hudson aged fifty years resident in the Town of Lewiston in the County and State aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of congress entitled, "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war."

The said John Hudson enlisted in the month of May in the year A.D. seventeen hundred and eighty one at Saratoga in the state aforesaid in the company commanded by Captain Aaron Austin of the first New York Regiment commanded by Colonel VanSchaick; that he continued to serve in the said corps or in the service of the United States until the month of June A.D. seventeen hundred eighty three when he was discharged from service at a place called Snake Hill in Orange County in the State aforesaid and in the New York line.
