His name appears on a list of Applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, class 9, page 93.

Rank: Corporal

Regt: Col. J. Clinton's

Disability: Wounded by a musket ball in the breast in an action in Canada.

When and where disabled: 1776, St. Pierre.

To what pension entitled: No disability.

Remarks: There are no musters of this regiment in this office.

Evidence transmitted by the District Court incompletely. Viz: No affidavits of his situation after. No evidence of his leaving the service. The affidavits of freeholders are wanting to prove his continued disability.
