

**Pension Application for Thomas Huntley**

Jobahim Goddard Esqr one of the Judges of the Sup'r Court in the State of Connecticut.

The Petition of Thomas Huntley of [Preston?] in the County of New London & State aforesaid Sheweth—

That he resides in the town & County aforesaid—That he served more than nine months in the war of the revolution upon the continental establishment as a private soldier.

That he is by reason of his reduced circumstances in life, in need of assistance from the country for his support.

That he never received any pension from the United States & hereby relinquishes his all claim to any such pension excepting by [?] of an act of Congress called an act to provide for those persons engaged in the land & naval service of the United States and a person under that act he is declares & substantiates his claim.(Signed with his mark) Thos. Huntley

Dated this 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818.

Be it remembered that on the thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eighteen personally came before me Calvin Goddard one of the Judges of the Superior Court in the State of Connecticut Thomas Huntley of Weston in said County & made oath to the truth of the following declaration by him subscribed viz. That he enlisted into the Army of the United States in the War of the Revolution upon the Continental Establishment sometime in the year AD 1776 for & during the war & that he continued to serve therein until the end of the revolutionary war & was honorably discharged therefrom in the month of June AD 1783—that he served the whole of the time in the Second New York Regiment commanded by Col. Philip VanCortland in a company commanded by Capt Hamtramck.

That he has never received any pension under any law of the United States & that he is by reason of his reduced circumstance in life in need of assistance from his county for his support. (Signed with his mark) Thomas Huntley.
