

Pension Application of Abraham Hyat

B.L.Wt.988-200-Lieut. Issued May 5, 1791.

Letter in folder dated February 16, 1920, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter received the 4th instant, you are advised that two hundred acres of bounty land were allowed on Warrant No. 988, which issued May 5, 1791, on account of the Revolutionary War services of Lieutenant Abraham Hyat of the New York troops. There is no further data on file relative to said soldier or his family owing to the destruction of the papers in such claim when the War Office was burned in 1800. A careful search of the records fails to show a claim for pension on file on account of his services.

The Revolutionary War records of this bureau fail to afford any information in regard to Colonel James Hindman and Lieutenant John Hindman.
