

Pension Application for James Ingals or Ingalls

W.23455 (Widow: Abigail) James married Abigail Slade May 26th 1785. James died about the 19 August 1828.

James Ingals was born May the 19th 176[blot].

Abigail Slade was born June the 24th 1767.

James Ingals and Abigail Slade was Married May the 26th 1785.

Abigail Ingals was Born February the 12th 1786.

Rosannah Ingals was born January the 31st 1788.

Leander Ingals was born November the 17th 1789 and died April the 24th 1792.

William Ingals was born October the 16th 1791.

Samuel Ingals was born November the 5th 1793.

Sabra Inngals was born September the 17th 1796.

Jeremiah Ingals was born May the 17th 1798 and died June the 30th 1824.

Deliae Ingals was born November the 26th 1801.

Olive Ingals was born June the 13th 1804.

At a County Court held at Elmira in & for the County of Chemung in the State of New York (the same being a Court of Record, having common law jurisdiction & a clerk & seal on the 9 April 1851.

Personally appeared in open court before the Judge aforesaid Abigail Ingals a resident of the said County aged eighty three – years & upwards who being duly sworn according to law doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of July 7, 1838 & the other acts of Congress in reference to widows pensions; that she is the widow of James Ingals who was a private in the militia of the State of New York in the war of the Revolution & rendered service in Col. K. VanRenselaer's Regiment of New York levies under Capt'n Turner, Ostrander, Schermerhorn & others as she is informed & believes & for proof of his service refers to the papers annexed.

She further declares that she was married to the said James Ingals, in Cheshire, (then called Lanesboro) in Berkshire County Massachusetts, by a magistrate named Harris on the 26th May 1785.

That her husband the aforesaid James Ingals died at Wells Bradford County Penn'a on or about the nineteenth of August 1828.

That she was not married to him prior to his leaving the service, but the marriage took place previous to the first day of January seventeen hundred and ninety four, to wit, at the time above stated.

She further states that he name before her said marriage was Abigail Slade, & that she is still a widow. (Signed) Abigail Ingals
