

### **Bounty Land for Nathaniel Irish**

B.L.Wt.1133-300-Capt. Issued Aug 30, 1791.

Also recorded under B.L.W.t.2591-300

Artillery Artificers

Letter in folder dated March 19, 1931, written in response to an inquiry.

You are advised that it appears from the records of this bureau that Warrant No. 2591, for 300 acres of bounty land, was issued August 30, 1791 on account of the services of Nathaniel Irish, captain of artillery artificers, War of the Revolution.

There are no further data on file in regard to his services, and none, whatever, in regard to his family because of the destruction of papers in such early claims when the War Office was destroyed by fire in 1800.

His age is not shown.

This is the history of the only soldier named Nathaniel Irish that is found on the Revolutionary war records of this bureau.

It is suggested that you apply to the Director of the New York State Library, Albany, New York, for information in regard to books in which you are interested.
