

### **Pension Application for Hannibal Jackson**

W. 21441 (Widow: Rachel) Married Rachel Frances 1775, Hannibal died September 1806, Rachel died July 27, 1841. Four surviving children: Annetye Myer wife of Harry Meyers, Polly Tillman widow of Robert Tillman, Joseph Jackson, and Richard Jackson.

Adam Brink of the town of Saugerties County and State aforesaid being duly sworn deposes and saith that he is eighty four years of age was a soldier in the revolutionary war and was well acquainted with Hanibal Jackson of the town of Woodstock of said County who was also a soldier.

That deponent was a private soldier in a company commanded by Capt. Hunter in Col. Pawlings Regt for the term of 8 or 9 months and was part of the time stationed on Hudson River, and in the fall said year he saw the said Hanibla Jackson as a private Soldier in Captain Evert Bogardus' Company of Militia from Ulster County but for what length of time deponent does not know:--

Deponent further saith that in the year 1782 deponent was engaged as a private in Captain Henry Pawlings Company in Col. Wysesfelts Regt for the term of 8 or 9 months and was stationed as a guard to protect the inhabitants of Ulster County on the frontiers and the said Hanibal Jackson was private soldier in the same company at the same time.

Deponent further saith that said Hanibal died several years since and left a widow whose name was Rachel Jackson with whom deponent was also well acquainted.

That said Hanibal and Rachel lived together as man and wife during the revolutionary war and ahd several children with whom deponent was also well acquainted.

Deponent further saith that several years after the death of said Hanibal his widow the said Rachel Jackson moved into Greene County into the town of Catskill and that deponent was informed she was also dead and that one [of] their children was applying for a pension for the Revolutionary Services of their father the said Hanibal Jackson and further this deponent saith not.
