Johnson, Robert

His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on April 25, 1794, and printed in the American State Papers, Class 9, page 93.

Rank: Private (1)

Disability: Wounded at the capture of Fort Montgomery.

When disabled: October 6, 1777.

Residence: New Windsor.

Remarks: There are no militia rolls in this office. Evidence transmitted by the District Court incomplete. No examination of physicians. No evidence of his leaving the service.
