

Pension Application for Isaac Jones

On this the 9th of May 1818, before me the subscriber, one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas & Record for the County of Dutchess personally appear Isaac Jones, aged seventy, resident in the Town of Dover in the county aforesaid, who being by me first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the provisions made by the late act of Congress, entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land & naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War. That he the said Isaac Jones enlisted in the State of New York, in a Regiment of Foot commanded by Col. Livingston & in a company commanded by Capt Iverson Child, that he served from Apl 1776 to Apl 1777, when he was discharged from the service in the State of New York, that he is in reduced circumstances & stands in need of the assistance of his county for support; that he has no other evidence now in his power of said services except the Affidavit of Abiathy Odell of the Town of Dover in the aforesaid County.
