W.26164 (Widow: Elizabeth) Married January 2, 1800. Samuel Died Oct 8, 1849 in Orange County.

On the 14 April 1818 before me the subscriber first Judge of the County of Orange in said state, personally appears Samuel Jones aged 57 years resident in Cornwall in said County, who being my me first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of congress, entitled "An act to provide for certain persons in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War".

That he the said Samuel Jones enlisted in Schenectady, State of N. York in the company commanded by Samuel Pell, Coln Cortlandt's 2 N.Y. Regt that he continued to serve in the said Corps or in the service of the United States til the end of the war when he was discharged at New Windsor in New York by Coln Cortlandt.

That he was in several skirmishes & at the taking of said Cornwallace--& that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support & has no other evidence now in his power of his said services. (Signed) Samuel Jones
