

Pension Application for Adam Kader

W.26167 (Widow: Nancy, who was the daughter of Frederick Keyser of the Town of Marbletown in Ulster County.)

Nancy Kader a resident of the town of Fulton in said County of Schoharie, aged 89 years, being further duly sworn according to law doth depose & say on her oath, that Deponent is now the widow of Adam Kader, deceased.

That in the month of June in the year seventeen hundred and ninety deponent was duly married to the said Adam Kader at Schoharie in said County by the Rev'd Mr. Waggenhaven.

That in the year 1788, she came from Marbletown in the County of Ulster in said State, to live in said Schoharie and after living in said Schoharie about two years was married as aforesaid.

That William Oliphant and Catharine Kerner then neighbors of Deponent in said Schoharie were married to each other at said Schoharie in the month of January seventeen hundred and ninety three & at the time that they were so married to each other deponent had been married to the said Adam Kader for more than two years and then had one child.

That her husband the said Adam Kader was a regular soldier during the War of the Revolution & served some three years or more & until the close of the said war in the companies of Captain Sackett & Captain Smith in the Regiment of Colonel Cortland & for which service he drew a lot of Land containing some six hundred acres as she believes in the interior of the State of New York.

That in or about the year seventeen hundred and ninety two it being some two years after her said marriage her husband the said Adam Kader sold his said Bounty Land to one William Campbell.

That deponent did not & would not sign or execute and deed or conveyance with her husband the said Adam Kader of the said Lot of Land to any person, and has never signed any writing conveying said Lot of Land to any person whatever, although she was requested to do so by her husband the said Adam Kader but that she refused to do so. (Signed with her mark) Nancy Kader
