

Bounty Land for John Katton

B.L.Wt.52-100

Know all men by these presents, that I John Katton of Rome in the County of Oneida and State of New York for the Consideration of ten Dollars received to my full satisfaction of Abijah Holbrook of Torrington Litchfield County and State of Connecticut, Do give, grant, bargain, sell, assign, and confirm, unto Abijah Holbrook or to his heirs, or assigns forever, all my right, title, interest and demand, which I have to the bounty land, which was granted to me, by the United States, for my services as a soldier during the late war with Great Britain: And I do hereby appoint the said Abijah Holbrook my true and lawful attorney for me, with power of substitution, and in my name to demand, ask and receive from the war office of the United States, for his use and benefit, whatever land I am entitled to for my services as a soldier in the Regiment Commanded by Coln Sheldon hereby irrevocably ratifying and confirming whatever my said attorney or his substitutes shall lawfully do, by virtue of these presents. In testimony whereof, I hereunto set my hand and seal, this thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred. (Signed) John Katton
