On this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty is, before me the Subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace for the said County of Essex personally appeared Aaron King who on his Oath declares that he is the same person who formerly belonged to the company commanded by Captain Amos Dodd in the Regiment commanded by Col. Phillip VanCortland, that he was disabled by a severe wound he received in an engagement with the enemy in the Revolutionary War, in the Service of the United States, that his name was placed on the pension list roll of the State of New Jersey, that he received a certificate of that fact under the signature of Isaac Smith Inspector of Invalids, the Original Pensions was three dollars and thirty nintieths (sic) per month and has since been raised to five dollars and one third per month.
