

Pension Application for Charles Knowles

B.L.Wt.1193-300-Capt. Issued April 13, 1782. Also recorded as above under B.L.Wt.2557. No papers.

Letter dated March 24, 1939.

Reference is made to your letter in which you request information in regard to Charles Knowles, of Connecticut, the Revolutionary War.

You are furnished herein the record of the only Charles Knowles found on file in the Revolutionary War records of this office. The surname was searched under similar spellings.

The records of this office show that Warrant #1193, or #2557, for three hundred acres of county land was issued April 13, 1792, on account of the service of Charles Knowles, Captain in Colonel Crane's Regiment of Artillery, War of the Revolution.

Because of the destruction of papers in such claims when the War Office was burned in 1800, there are no further data on file regard in regard to his service, and no data relative to family.
