

Bounty Land for John Lamb

Letter dated August 9, 1932.

Reference is made to your request for information relative to Colonel John Lamb of New York.

The records of this office show that Warrant #1250 for five hundred acres of bounty land was issued August 20, 1790, on account of the service of John Lamb as Colonel of the Second Regiment of Artillery during the Revolutionary War.

There are no further data on file relative to Colonel John Lamb and no data relative to his family because of the destruction of the papers in the claim when the war office was burned in 1800.

This office has no record of a claim for pension having been made on account of the Revolutionary war service of Colonel John Lamb.
