Joseph Labo, of Rouses' point, being duly sworn, doth depose and say, that he was a private in Colo Livingston's regiment of the New York line, in the army of the revolution; that he enlisted for and during the war; that he served the greatest part of the time in Colo Livingston's regiment; and about the six last years of his service, he served in Colo Hazen's Regiment, and continued to serve in said regiment, until the war was ended, and he was regularly discharged. And deponent is knowing that John Baptist Labonte served in the same manner. And deponent further saith not.
