

## **Pension Application for John Langdon**

(No. 1 Declaration)

I John Langdon of the Town of Whitehall in the County of Washington and State of New York Do according to the Act of Congress of the United States of America entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and Naval Service of the United States in the revolutionary War" make the following Declaration under oath, that is to say—

I do Solemnly Declare that I am a resident citizen of the United States and that I was such Citizen on the Eighteenth day of March last—To wit of the Town County and State aforesaid and that by reason of my reduced circumstances in life I am in need of Assistance from my County for support—

I do further Declare that I was a Second Lieutenant in the War of the revolution and that I served as such in the War of the revolution against the Common enemy for the Term of one year & four months or more during the said War on the Continental establishment.

That I belonged to the Company commanded by Capt Andrew Billings in the Regiment commanded by Col. James Clinton and In the line of New York forces—

And that afterwards I belonged to a Company Commanded by Capt Abraham Schaick in Col. Jacobus Swartwouts Regiment and in the line of New York forces always acting as Lieutenant under the Commission hereunto annexed.

And I do further declare that I entered into the said service on or before the first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five and left the said service on or about the tenth day of December in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy six having left eh same by reason of a new arrangement of the officers in my Company and Regiment and as I understood of the Army generally being made, in consequence or which I was not assigned to any particular command under my said commission and left the said service as a supernumerary and I do further declare that I am the same person described in and to whom the annexed commission was originally directed and delivered—and further that I hereby relinquish all claim to every and any pension allowed me by the laws of the United States or of any individual State previous to the eighteenth day of Marhc last.
