

Bounty Land Application for Ebenezer Leech.

B.L.Wt.24-100

Letter in folder dated April 14, 1927, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you from the records of this Bureau, it appears that Ebenezer Leech was a corporal in Colonel Moses Hazen's Continental Regiment, War of the Revolution, and served until the close.

Warrant No. 24 for 100 acres of bounty land was allowed in full satisfaction for the services rendered.

In 1800 he was living in Whitestown, Oneida County, New York. His age is not stated.

There is not data on file as to his family.

The above noted Ebenezer Leech (Leach) is the only soldier of the name found on the Revolutionary War records of this Bureau.
