

Pension Application for Lyman Lee

R.20397 -- Drummer for Capt. Fowler N.Y. Line.

For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of an act for the relief of certain surviving officers and [Laborers] of the arms of the Revolution appeared the 15th of May 1828 I Lyman Lee of the Town of New Windsor in the County of Orange in the State of New York do hereby declare that I enlisted in the Continental line of the War of the Revolution for and during the war and continued in its service until its termination at which period I was a drummer in Captain Fowlers Company in the VanCortland's Regiment of the line of the State of New York and I also declare that I was entitled to a certificate for the reward of eighty dollars under a resolve of Congress passed May 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the fifteenth day of March 1828 on the pension list of the United States. (Signed) Lyman Lee

Sworn this 19th day of May 1832 before me Ward M. Garlay, Justice of the Peace, Orange County N.Y.
