

Pension Application for Jacob Lent

On this twenty fifth day of September 1820 personally appeared in Open Court being a Court of Record for the said County Jacob Lent aged sixty years resident in the town of Cortlandt in the said County of Westchester who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on his Oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows.

That eh enlisted in the year 1779 for and during the War in Captain Mottos Company in Colonel John Lambs Regiment of Artillery and that he served in the said Regiment Militia the termination of the said War when he was discharged.

That he was present at the Capture of the Army under the command of Lord Cornwallis in Virginia—

That the date of his Original declaration was in April 1818 and that a Certificate of his pension passed the War Office on the 15th day of August 1818 and the number of the said Certificate is 2275 and that he has received the pension from the 3d day of April 1818 until the 4th day of March last past.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by Gift Sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled “an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and Naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War” passed on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or Securities Contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed and by me Subscribed, and that I am of no occupation but a Common Labourer.

That he has a wife and five Children viz, his wife 48 years old and his Children Elithea 17 years, Hester 14 years, Abraham 12 years Adah 7 years and Catherine six years old, all or most of them dependent upon him for support, and That he is in indigent Circumstances as to be unable to support himself without the Assistance of his Country.
