Avery Lewis of the Town of Aurelius in the County of Cayuga & State of New York being duly sworn deposeth and saith that in the year 1776 on the fifteenth day of June he enlisted into the army of the United States as a private soldier in the company of Capt. Thomas Mitchell in the company of Capt Thomas Mitchell in the Second New York Regiment commanded by Colo Malcum and Genl Scotts Brigade for the term of three years or longer is the war continued and he this deponent further saith that he served the full term of three years as a good and faithful soldier and was honorably discharged at Paramus in the year 1779 by Genl Washington—and this deponent further saith that his discharge is lost. . . and that by reason of reduced circumstances in life he is in need of assistance for support from his country & further saith not.
