

Pension Application for Henry Lewis

Came on the fifteenth day of January 1822 in open court-Henry Lewis of the County of Schenectady, who being duly sworn according to law, doth on his Oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the Act of Congress of the 18th day of March 1818 and the act supplementary hereto of 1st May 1820.

That he the said Henry Lewis enlisted in Capt'n Rosecrant Company, Col. Lewis Dubois Regiment New York line in the Revolutionary War in the year one thousand seven hundred & seventy eight & continued in service about ten months and a half in said company and Regiment, when he was discharged for Inability - from said Regiment—which discharge is lost and that he has no evidence in his power—but what is [?] and I do solemnly swear—that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th of March 1818—and that I have not since that time - by gift, sale, or in any manner dispersed of any property or any part thereof, with Intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an Act of Congress entitled an Act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war passed the 18th March 1818—and that I have not nor has any person for me, in trust, any property or securities, contracts or debts due to me nor have I any other than what is contained int he Schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed.
