

### **Pension Application for Isaac Lewis**

W.2134 (Widow: Hannah) There is no deposition by Isaac in the folder.

Isaac Lewis was borne Oct 10<sup>th</sup> 1763

Hannah Lewis was borne April 17<sup>th</sup> 1763

Hester VanValen was borne January 1<sup>th</sup> 1783

Mary Marvin was borne January 19<sup>th</sup> 1785

Sarah Smith was borne August 18<sup>th</sup> 1789

Jonas Little was borne Sept 19<sup>th</sup> 1787

Rebecca Secor was borne Sept 20<sup>th</sup> 1797

Jacob Lewis was borne November 2<sup>th</sup> 1798

Peter Lewis was borne August 19<sup>th</sup> 1801

Thomas Lewis was borne Sept 23<sup>th</sup> 1803

Hannah and Isaac were married November 20, 1796. Isaac died July 2, 1838.

Letter in folder dated September 18, 1939, written in response to an inquiry.

The data which follow were obtained from papers on file in pension claim, W.2134, based upon service of Isaac Lewis in the Revolutionary War.

Isaac Lewis was born October 10, 1763, place of his birth and names of his parents are not shown.

He enlisted at the beginning of the war and served until 1781, a part of the time in Captain Thomas McKinstry's company, Colonel William Malcolm's New York Regiment of levies; enlisted about the first of April 1782, served about nine months in Captains Frenches Smith's and Abraham Westfall's companies, Colonels Woodhull's and Weissenfels' New York regiment of levies. His service was rendered at White Plains, Cherry Valley and on the Hudson and Mohawk Rivers.

Isaac Lewis died July 2, 1838, in Monroe Orange, County.

Isaac Lewis married about April 15, 1796, in New Windsor, Orange County, New York or November 20, 1796, in Cornwall, Orange County, New York, (both tenants appear in the file), Mrs. Hannah Little, the daughter of James Galloway, born April 17, 1763. The place of her birth and name of her mother are not shown. Hannah married Timothy Little January 14, 1783, and he died in February 1791.

The soldier's widow, Hannah Lewis, was allowed pension n on her application executed December 25, 1841, at which time she was a resident of Monroe, Orange County, New York.

Jacob Lewis born, November 2, 1798

Peter Lewis born, August 19, 1801, was deceased in 1849.

Thomas Lewis born September 23, 1803

Jonas Little born, September 19, 1787.

In 1849, Thomas Lewis was residing in Monroe, New York. In the same year, Hester VanValen, was also residing in Monroe, New York, her relationship not stated.
