

Pension Application for John Limbocker

W.5024 (Widow: Lovinia) Served under Colonel Gansevoort. Enlisted in February 1777, Captain Cornelius Johnson, 3rd New York Regiment, enlisted for "during the war". He was discharged at the end of the war.

County of Jackson SS.

On this fifteenth day of August eighteen hundred and forty three personally appeared before the undersigned one of the associate Judges of the Circuit Court in and for the County of Jackson aforesaid Lovinia Limbocker a resident of the Town of Leoni in the County of Jackson and State of Michigan aged seventy eight years and upwards who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 7, 1838 entitled "An act granting half pay and pensions to certain widows".

That she is the widow of John Limbocker who was a private in the War of the Revolution what particular service he rendered other engagements he was in she cannot state, but reference being had to the papers and proofs already on file in the war office of the United States will fully and at large appear.

She further declares that she was married to the John Limbocker on the first day of February in the year seventeen hundred and eighty five that her husband the aforesaid John Limbocker died on the ninth day of August in the year eighteen hundred and seventy nine, that she was not married to him prior to his leaving the service but the marriage took place, previous to the first day of January seventeen hundred and ninety four viz at the terms above stated.

She further states that she was married to the said John Limbocker in the town of Little Brittan Orange County and State of New York.

That she does not know of any man living that was present at the time of her marriage neither does she know of any record of her said marriage except the family record which is hereto attached.

She further declares that she has not intermarried since the decease of her said husband John Limbocker and further saith not. (Signed with her mark) Lovina Limbocker
