

Pension Application for Gilbert James Livingston

On this Thirtieth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and Twenty personally appeared in open court being a court of Record called the Common Pleas Court, for the said County of Greene, Gilbert J. Livingston, aged sixty one, resident of the Town of Cattskill in the said County of Greene, who being first duly sworn according to law; doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary war, as follows, In Captain Barrent TenEycks company and Colonel Van Cortlandts Regiment of the second New York line of the Continental troops, that the original Declaration of the said Gilbert J. Livingston, for the benefit of the act entitled “an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War; passed on the 18th day of March 1818—bears date the twenty seventh day of April 1818, to the best of his knowledge and belief, and is inscribed on the pension list Roll of the New York agency, by certificate number 2285, and I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time, by fits sale, or in any manner disposed of my property and any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary war, passed on the eighteenth day of March 1818—and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or annuities, contracts or Debts due to me, nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed.

I have no property either real or personal, except my necessary wearing apparel.

I am by occupation a teacher of common schools my ability to pursue that employment is impaired so as to render me unable to pursue it, for the want of good eye sights and I have no family and further that I am much afflicted with the Rheumatism, and thereby rendered unable to labor for my support.
