

Pension Application for James Lloyd

County of Litchfield

County Court of Common Pleas. ON this 25th day of December 1822 personally appeared in open Court, being a Court of Record for said County, in said District, having power to fine & imprison, James Lloyd, aged fifty six years, resident in Sharon in s'd County, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War, as follows, for a term of one year in the Regiment under the command of Col. James Clinton, and that after his discharge from said Regiment, again enlisted in the Company under the command of Capt. Titus in the Regiment commanded by Harry B. Livingstone, in the New York line, under the Continental Establishment, and that said enlistment was for and during the war, and the deponent was soon after his enlistment transferred to the company commanded by John Davis, in said Regiment, and the deponent served about one year in said last mentioned Regiment, when he was honorably discharged by Brigadier Genl. Poor.

This Deponent made application for a Pension to the War Department on the tenth day of April 1818.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March one thousand eight hundred eighteen; & that I have not since that time by gift, sale, or in any other manner, disposed of my property, or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provision of an Act of Congress entitled "an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War" passed on the 18th day of March March [sic] one thousand eight hundred eighteen and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities, contracts or debts due to me, nor have I any income other than what is mentioned in the schedule hereto annexed & by me subscribed—that I am by occupation a Farmer, and have a wife by the name of Lucy, fifty six years of age to support.
