I Baptiste Malbeuf aged seventy four years do upon oath testify and declare that in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy six I enlisted for the term of “during the war” and served in the regiment commanded by Colonel James Levingston in Captain John Baptiste Labonte’s company of the New York line, and that I continued in the service aforesaid untill the close of the war when I was regularly discharged from said Regiment.

I further declare that I have never received a warrant for the Bounty Lands promised to me on the part of the United States nor have I ever assigned or transferred my claim in any means whatsoever.

Therefore know all men by these presents that I Baptiste Malbeuf aforesaid do hereby constitute and appoint Bela Edgerton of Rowes Point to be my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name to demand and receive from the Secretary of war of the United States a warrant for the quantity of land due to me as aforesaid and my said attorney is hereby fully authorized and empowered to constitute and appoint one or more substitutes or attorneys under him for the special purposes above expressed.
