

Pension Application for James Mackenny, Mackaney, Mackeny, or Mackney

W.19858 (Widow: Mary) John married Mary Decker on September 1791, John died January 10, 1837.

Northern District of New York

Ulster County SS.

On this nineteenth day of September 1820 personally appeared in open Court in the Court of common Pleas it being a Court of Record for the said County of Ulster James Mackenny aged sixty six years resident in the said County of Ulster who being duly sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows.

Enlisted in 17. . [sic] in the state of New York in Capt Charles Brodheads Company, Col. Malcomb Regiment of Infantry New York Troops served during the war until 17 . . when he was honorably discharged in New Windsor Town New York State No. of Pension Certificate 10044 original declaration made. . . 1818.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of the act of Congress entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War" passed the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the following inventory and by me subscribed viz.

No. Real Estate.

On cow worth \$12, two hogs worth \$4, household property worth \$4 and I am in Debt about \$12. My family consists of my wife, aged forty seven years, one son aged thirteen years, a common laborer that at present lame in the shoulder from Rheumatism. (Signed with his mark) James Mackenny

Sworn and subscribed on this 19th day of Sept 1820 in open Court & his Inventory determined at twenty dollars.
