

Pension Application for Jared Madge or Mudge

On this 23rd day of October in the year 1832 personally appeared before his Honor Sherman Page Esquire one of the Judges of the Court of Com'n Pleas in & for the County of Otsego Jared Mudge a resident of the Town of Unadilla in the County of Otsego and State of New York aged seventy five years and eight months who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following Declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of congress pass'd the 7th of June 1832—

That he entered the service of the United States under the following named officers and served as herein stated—to wit:

That he enlisted as a private soldier at New Lebanon in the State of New York in the Spring of the year 1777 for one year In the Comp'y commanded by Capt. White in the Regiment commanded by Colo'e Waterman New York State Troops and was ordered up to Fort George—That he march'd with said Regiment to Fort Edward and to various places with the Army through the Northern Campaign—That htye Pretreated before Burgoine's Army to Stillwater.

That he was In the Battle at Bennington and also at the Taking of Gen'l Burgoine's Army and that he remained at Stillwater and at Stillwater and at Saratoga Lake untill his time was served out viz, in the Spring of the year 1778—When he again Immediately enlisted at Saratoga in the same Comp'y and Regiment for one year and was ordered up the Mohawk River to JohnsTown—German Flatts and to various places with which said company and Sections of the Army through that Campaign and was march'ed back to Saratoga & from thence to Albany where he was discharged after having served out the said year for which he had engaged the second time as aforesaid—that he had a discharge signed by Captain White which he has lost many years ago and considered it of no use or Consequence there—He further saith that he was int he Battle at Stone Robby up the Mohawk when Colo Brown was Kill'd.

That he has no Documentary Evidence and knows of no other evidence of his services that he can procure except what is hereto annexed—that from Mudge who made the applicant hereto annexed is not living—but did make said affidavit to his former application which was similar to this the same services in the same Regiment.

That he hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to ;a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of the agency of any state. (Signed) Jared Madge
