

**Pension Application for William Mahy**

Original Claim

The State of Maryland

Baltimore County to wit.

On this [blank] day of July 1822 personally appeared in Baltimore County Court for the Sixth Judicial District in the State of Maryland, (being a Court of Record) William Mahy resident in said County, aged seventy three years and upwards, who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the Act of Congress of the 18<sup>th</sup> March 1818 and the 1<sup>st</sup> May 1820; that he the said William Mahy enlisted at Albany in the State of New York in the month of January 1772 in a Company of Artillery commanded by Captain John Locust attached to the Corps of Artillery No 1 Commanded by Colonel Talbott, that he continued in the said company until the month of December in the year 1781 when he was discharged at Norfolk in the State of Virginia. That he was in the Battle of Brandy Wine, Mud Fort, Long Island and at the Capture of Cornwallis.

And in pursuance of the Act of the 1<sup>st</sup> May 1820 I solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States, on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818; and that I have not since that time, by gift, sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of congress entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and Naval services of the United States, in the Revolutionary War" passed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day or March 1818, and that I have not, nor has any person in trust for me, any property or Securities, Contracts or debts, due to me; nor have I any income other than what is contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and by me subscribed.

Schedule

Property—none—

That he is by profession a mariner, has no family; and by reason of his age, and infirmity is unable to any longer to pursue his profession, and that he is in such reduced circumstances as to require the assistance of his Country for support.
