

**Pension Application for William McCain**

R.6592 (Widow: Charlotte)

Letter in folder dated April 20, 1907, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated the 12<sup>th</sup> ultimo and received the 15<sup>th</sup>, you are advised that Charlotte, widow of William McCain, of Orange County, New York, applied for pension (Rejected File No. 6592) under the Act of July 4, 1836, which was not allowed on account of defective proof. Her application was forwarded to Congress and does not appear to have been returned to this Bureau.

A careful search of the records of this Bureau fails to show that a claim was filed on account of the Revolutionary War services of Jesse Jennings or Jeremiah Curtiss of New York.
