

**Pension Application for Patrick McGee or Magee**

W.9184 (Widow: Zadia) Married November 18, 1814. Patrick died at Lysander, Onondaga County August 19, 1820.

Patrick McGee being duly sworn saith that in the month of May in the year seventeen hundred & seventy eight he enlisted as a private soldier in Captain Hughes company in Colonel Hazen's Regiment in General Poors Brigade in the Continental Army for during the war—and served in the same until the new management of the army when he was transferred into Captain Satterles Company in said Regiment in which he served until the army marched to the southward to the taking of Genl Cornwallis, when this deponent remained at Fishkill on the Hudson River under Lieutenant General of said company to take charge of the Invalids where he remained some time & then had a furlow to go home & was at home at the time the army was discharged & this deponent afterwards returned to the encampment at Fishkill & finding that the invalids of said Regiment had removed to West Point, where this deponent went & found the said Lieutenant General who informed this deponent that he had returned the name of this deponent the same as if he had been present but he did not get and written discharge—that he is now aged fifty six years in the month of November last & resides in the town of Onondaga and from his reduced circumstances in life he is in need of assistance from his country for support & further saith not. (Signed) Patrick McGee.

Letter in folder dated August 30, 1923, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, W.9184, it appears that Patrick McGee or Magee was born Nov. 1761, and enlisted May 1778 and served as a private in Captains Hughes and Satterlee's companies, Colonel Hazen's Continental regiment, until close of the war.

He was allowed pension on his application executed Apr. 9, 1818, while ar resident of Onondaga, N.Y. he died at Lysander, N.Y. Aug. 19, 1820.

Soldier married at Lysander, N.Y. Nov. 18, 1814, Zadia Williams, she was allowed pension on her application executed Jan. 30, 1856, while living in Granby, Owego Co., N.Y. aged 76 years.

There is no further family data on file.

The above is the only soldier named Patrick McGee (Magee) found on the Revolutionary War records of this Bureau.
